

Nordic Championship Trial 2026

October 3 – 4 2026

Welcome to the 2026 Nordic Championship in Trial. This year the competition will be held in Norway, more specifically in Hobøl, and the south-eastern part of Norway and around 45 km from Oslo.

The paddock will be located right at the race site, in the area that Hobøl Motorklubb usually uses and some of you have already been here before. There will be showers, toilets and possibilities for electricity in the arena. The paddock-fee is 45€ (500 NOK) for the weekend, and you pay the fee up front and together with the entry fee. Remember to write down the car registration number on the vehicle when you pay.

The electricity is available from 16.00 on Friday to 16.00 on Sunday, but the paddock is open for arrival from 12.00 on Thursday.

There will be a kiosk and the opportunity to buy for example burgers, soda, coffee and other things. More information on this will come, but we want to keep the payment by card or vipps.

3. October – The individual race

Classes: Championship, Junior, Women, Youth, +40, +60, open blue, open green and open yellow.

The round is 3 km long. Championship, Junior, Women and Youth are driving 12 sections, 3 rounds. +40, +60 and the open classes are driving 12 sections and 2 rounds.

Free start in the first round, from round 2 there is a forced starting order from section 1.

4. October – The team race

Classes: Championship, Junior, Women, Youth, +40, +60, open blue, open green and open yellow.

The round is 3 km long, and all classes are driving 12 sections and 2 rounds.

Free start in the first round, from round 2 there is a forced starting order from section 1.

Entry fee for the team race is: 40€ (440 NOK) for
rider and 25€ (275 NOK) for assistant/minder.

Additional important information:

- Motorcycles are prohibited in areas other than the designated area notify by the organizer and within the allowed time only. No driving in the paddock or after you have delivered your card/finished the race.
- In our motorsports regulations (Norway) it is mandatory to use back protectors and knee pads during races.
- Mostly for the Norwegian drivers: The order and difficulty level of the open yellow and open green classes is opposite to what is normally done in races here in Norway. Open yellow is the easiest class in the unofficial classes.
- A little reminder that the regulations for Nordic championship, it states that the assistants/minders must have an approved Trial-helmet and at all time wear leather boots, long trousers and a long-sleeved shirt. They need approved license from your country, must also be 18 years old, and it is important to register the assistants/minders, both walking and driving.
